

HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES 2022 EUROPE VOYAGES

BEFORE CRUISING



Prior to Travel

All guests ages five and above will require a medically observed, negative viral COVID-19 test (PCR or antigen) result taken within 3-days of embarkation (for Greece embarkations the requirement is 2-day antigen or 3-day PCR COVID-19 test).

Guests under 5 years of age do not need to be vaccinated. Children between the ages of 5-11 who are not vaccinated may request an exemption at the time of booking and if approved may be subject to additional testing and protocols.

Proof of full vaccination, including booster if eligible. For these cruises the definition of “fully vaccinated” is at least 14 days and no more than 270 days (9 months) since the last dose in the primary vaccine series of an approved COVID-19 vaccine. Only one booster dose is required for guests 18 years of age and older whose final dose of an approved/authorized COVID-19 vaccine is older than 270 days (9 months) to be considered “fully vaccinated.” Guests 18 years of age and older who are eligible for, but have not received a booster may request an exemption at the time of booking and if approved may be subject to additional testing, fees and protocols. Exemptions will be limited and are not guaranteed.



Online or Navigator® App Check-in

Download the [Navigator App](#) or log into [hollandamerica.com](#). Complete the Vaccine Attestation, Cruise Contract and Risk Acknowledgment as soon as possible. Complete the pre-cruise Health Questionnaire and get your boarding pass and check-in time 72-24 hours before embarkation.

VERIFLY

VeriFLY

For faster check-in, we encourage the use of [VeriFLY](#), a secure, free digital health application that allows guests the ability to easily upload required pre-embarkation information like proof of vaccination and negative COVID-19 test results. Guests who have obtained their VeriFLY pass must still complete the online check-in process.



EMBARKATION

Bring your required ID and show completion of your health questionnaire and risk acknowledgement. Guests who have obtained their VeriFLY pass (digital or printed), please look for the VeriFLY signs when entering the terminal at your assigned check-in time.

Present your original vaccination card or COVID-19 certificate or QR codes, showing the vaccine type, the date of each vaccine administered, the individuals name and date of birth or other identifier. The EU digital COVID-19 certificate will also be accepted.

Bring negative, medically observed COVID-19 test result taken within 3-days of embarkation. For guests embarking in Greece, bring your antigen test result taken with 2-days or PCR within 3-days of embarkation.



WHILE CRUISING

Masks are recommended on board but not required. We highly recommend guests wear a mask in specific venues and during other congregate events.



SHORESIDE EXPERIENCES

Fully vaccinated guests can explore destinations on their own or on independent third-party tours. The ability for guests to go ashore in ports of call is controlled by the governments of the ports we visit. Please be aware that as destination conditions change, you may be required to take a Holland America Line shore excursion to go ashore.



PRE-DISEMBARKATION TEST

If a negative antigen COVID-19 test is required for re-entry into your home country, Holland America Line will cover the costs of a COVID-19 test which will be conducted on board prior to disembarkation upon proof of same-day travel plans.
